Former Director of the Geophysical Research Center of the University of Lisbon (2001-2004). He studied at the University of Lisbon, where he graduated in 1981 in Physics. His research activity is focused on Marine Geophysics and Natural Hazards. He is author or co-author of more than 100 articles published in leading ISI journals, namely: Journal of Geophysical Research, Earth and Planetary Science Letters, Geophysical Research Letters and Nature, with more than 3000 ISI citations.
