



Paulo Ferrão

Dr. Paulo Ferrão is Full Professor at Instituto Superior Técnico -University of Lisbon and was awarded the title of Distinguished Professor at IST in 2021. He is President of IN+, Center for Innovation, Technology, and Development Policies Studies. He served as President of the Foundation for Science and Technology from 2016 to 2019 and was Director of the MIT-Portugal Program from 1996 to 2016. He was President of COST – "European Cooperation in Science and Technology" from 2019 to 2021, and a board member of the European association EUREKA from 2019 to 2023. He was also a member of the Environmental Advisory

Committee at Rolls-Royce. He is the author and co-author of nine books, more than 120 articles published in scientific journals, several book chapters, and over a hundred articles presented at conferences and invited lectures in various fields.

He has been active in the field of "Sustainable Cities," co-authoring a book published by MIT-Press titled "Sustainable Urban Metabolism". He is a member and deputy coordinator of the European Commission's Mission Board on "Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities" and has collaborated with the "U.S. National Academies" as a member of the "Sustainability Roundtable," the committee on "Sustainability Linkages in the Federal Government," and the committee "Pathways to Urban Sustainability: Challenges and Opportunities for the United States." He led the urban development component in two projects of the "ADB- Asian Development Bank," which resulted in the publication "Urban Metabolism of Six Asian Cities".
