



Anastasios Sextos

Dr. Anastasios Sextos is a Professor of Earthquake Engineering at the University of Bristol, UK. He is the Head of the Earthquake and Geotechnical Engineering Research Group and the Director of the new £12million National UK Facility on Soil-Foundation-Structure Interaction (SoFSI) of the University of Bristol. He is a member of the European Project Team for the Evolution of Structural Eurocodes and a member of the Management Board of the £140million UK Network for Research on Infrastructure and Cities (UKCRIC). He is an Associate Editor for the ASCE Journal of Structural Engineering, Earthquake Spectra and the Journal of Earthquake Engineering. Since 2023 he holds a dual appointment

at the National Technical University of Athens, while he is also serving as the President of the National Committee for Pre-Earthquake Inspection of Public Buildings in Greece. Anastasios's research contributions are in the areas of experimental and computational earthquake engineering and the resilience of critical infrastructure.
