Principal Researcher at LNEC, with a PhD and Habilitation in Civil Engineering (IST). He is cahrtered as Advisory Member of the Portuguese Association of Engineers (OE) and an Expert in Acoustics Engineering, by the Portuguese Association of Engineers. He is President of the Portuguese Acoustics Society and was President of the Ibero-American Acoustics Federation (in two-year periods 2006-2008, 2008-2010, 2010-2012 and 2012-2016) and President of the European Acoustics Association (EAA), in the three-year period 2016-2019, representing also this entity in the Noise Experts Group (NEG) of the European Commission. He was President of the Technical Committee for Standardization on Acoustics, Vibrations and Shocks – CT28 -, under the auspices of the Portuguese Institute for Quality and is the national representative in the European Committee for

Standardization, CEN/TC126, on Building Acoustics. His area of specialization focuses on Building Acoustics, but he also carries out relevant activities in the field of Environmental Acoustics, providing, in the frame of his activity, technical support for the development and implementation of legal and regulatory processes necessary for the country. He has organized several courses, seminars, workshops and conferences (nationally and internationally) in the field of Acoustics, and has supervised several Master's and PhD thesis at several national and foreign Universities, developing and coordinating programmed research, contract research, and the participation in national and international R&D projects. He is the author and/or co-author of around 250 publications, including Technical Notes and LNEC Reports, journal articles, conference papers, and other publications in specialized newspapers and magazines. He is the author of 9 books on Acoustics, among which the title "Acústica nos Edifícios" (Acoustics in Buildings) stands out and is widely used by the Portuguese technical and licensing community.
