Marta Vicente is an architect engaged in research projects and studies in the fields of architecture, engineering, and social sciences. She holds a Bachelor's degree in Architectural Studies (2013) and a Master's degree in Architecture (2016), both from the Faculty of Architecture of the University of Lisbon. In 2016, she began her professional career as an intern at the National Laboratory for Civil Engineering (LNEC), where she has since been collaborating with the Urban and Territorial Studies Unit of the Buildings Department.
